


March is Reading Month



FARMERS CAN HELP PROTECT OUR ROADS

THE ROAD COMMISSION WANTS YOU TO KNOW . . . Farmers can help protect our roads by avoiding the road right-of-way when tilling and planting their crops, such as soybeans, corn, asparagus, pickles, etc. Any crops planted in the right-of-way are there at the farmers' risk and no compensation for loss of crops in the right-of-way will be considered pursuant to Road Commission Policy 2022-02. All crops must be planted beyond 14' from the road's edge, or behind the "Back Slope" of an existing ditch. Roadside ditches cannot be backfilled by property owners or their tenants.

Road Commission staff and its contractors will be strictly enforcing the Road Commission's statutory right to mow or control brush in the county road right-of-way. Cooperation in keeping the right-of-way free of anything un-permitted by the Road Commission except authorized mailbox mountings is essential.

His 35 years at Western included teaching both on campus and at numerous off campus extension class locations throughout the state. He also spent time within the Agriculture Department and developed a keen

Charlie Heller, and they have published over thirty papers and articles about rural Michigan history. He
was particularly proud of being able to document how many Michigan women were rural landowners

He was president of the WMU Theatre Guild, a member and advisor to Phi Alpha Theta and Emeritus Council President. He and Carolyn provided scholarships and support to numerous WMU students John and Carolyn were also deeply involved in multiple volunteer roles in the community including the founding of Kalamazoo in Bloom and the Binder Park Zoo in Battle Creek.
